

KIDANGO OHLONE LAB

COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

What time is the lab open?

7:00 AM - 6:00 PM

When can I do my observation?

Any time you like during lab hours (7:00-6:00) except nap time between 1-3:00

What do I need before I can do observation?

As soon as Mitchell or Master Teachers get the following three items from you:

A current TB Test or x-ray

Statement Acknowledging Requirement to Report Child Abuse (*get a copy at the lab*)

Criminal Record Statement (*get a copy at the lab*)

What if I don't have my current TB test yet?

You may do the observation in the observation room. Keep in mind that you cannot hear the children clearly in the observation room because there are no speakers yet!

Where do I sign up for Lab Hours?

Outside each classroom there is a clipboard with the sign up sheet.

Sign up sheet will go up every Friday at 5:00 for the following week.

How many ECS students are allowed to be in the classroom at the same time?

Only FOUR (4) and you must wear your name tag.

How many students are allowed to be in the play yard?

No limit

What do I need to bring with me to do observation?

Only a note book and something to write with (your own pen/pencils)

Staff will ask you to leave the room if you have you purse or back pack with you.

Do not use your cell phone in the classroom or play yard.

Who can sign off my observation log?

Master Teachers (Shilpa, Kavita, Nancy, Zakia and Jamie).

Make sure Master Teachers sign you in and sign you out.

If I need to use the restroom or break, where do I go?

ECS students are to use the restroom outside next to CD 122 (your classroom)

If you need to take a break, find somewhere in the lobby or picnic tables in the parking lot. (Let us know you are going and/or when you are coming back)

Please do not use the restrooms inside the lab (for staff only)

Please do not use the staff lounge for break. (for staff only)

If I need to make copy/copies, where do I go?

Across the street to the postal annex

On campus

Check with your instructors (Professor McDowell or Dr. Jones)

Please do not ask to use the lab copy machine.

When is a good time to ask Master Teachers or Center director questions?

When they are not with children or parents. Do not interrupt them as they are interacting with children or meeting with parents.

You may schedule an appointment and come with your list of questions.
