

# Questions to Ask Yourself

## When Observing Children

1. What did you specifically see?

- Type of Play
- Domain Area

2. What does this child know how to do?

- Incremental Developmental Steps
- Describe in detail what you see the child doing

3. Connection to the next developmental level and / or School Readiness

4. What developmental theme was the child engaged in?

- "Roxaboxen" brainstorm & childhood memories
- Underlying themes as discussed in "Setting Sail" & "Thinking Big", i.e., loss & rescue, feeling powerful,

5. How would you name the essence of this experience for this child?

6. What does this child find frustrating?

- Unmet needs
- Developmental skills
- Environmental challenges

7. How does this child feel about herself or himself?

8. What would support this child's continued involvement in this activity?
